



Shipping Instructions

These handcrafted eggs are quite fragile and require special packaging to insure that they will arrive at their destination intact.

All eggs we sell will come wrapped in bubble wrap inside a gift box. There should always be enough bubble wrap and Styrofoam popcorn to insure there is no movement of the egg within the gift box.

Step-by-Step Instructions:

1. Select a shipping box that is 3-5" larger than the gift box on all sides including the top and bottom. While 3" is good, 5" will be better.
2. Before placing the gift box inside the shipping box, partially fill the box with at least 3-5" of Styrofoam packaging popcorn. Other types of packaging material such as shredded newspaper are not recommended since this does not provide the same cushioning.



Step 3: Gift Box Placed Inside Shipping Box

3. Place the gift box on top of the popcorn inside the shipping box maintaining the minimum distance between the shipping and gift boxes.
4. Fill the shipping box with popcorn to just slightly overflowing. This will ensure that the gift box will not move or rattle around inside the shipping box.
5. If you are shipping more than one egg maintain 1/2-1" space between gift boxes making sure the clearance between gift boxes and shipping box is maintained. Fill the space between gift boxes with popcorn.
6. Fold the box flaps down and secure the shipping box with suitable packaging tape.

An egg that has lattice work or large clay loops is extremely fragile. It is recommended that you let us package these eggs for you.
